## Highlights of the Week

- CHMSU educators from all four campuses convened at the Talisay Campus Multipurpose Gym for the Institutional Faculty Assembly, signaling the start of Academic 2025-2026. President Year Norberto Mangulabnan presented institutional milestones and achievements while the vice presidents gave updates and progress reports their respective offices. Clarifications on policies were raised, concerns were addressed, and feedback provided was in response the presentations.
- digitalization initiatives through the launch of its new Learning Module System (LMS), Human Resource Information System (HRIS), and allied platforms for data management held last August 26, 2025 at the Function Hall, Talisay Campus. The launch marked a significant step toward CHMSU's broader goals in digitalization and internationalization.
- Faculty members from all four campuses came together at the Talisay Campus Multipurpose Gym August 27, 2025 for the CHMSU Faculty Alliance General Assembly and Election of Officers for the



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2025–2027 term. The newly-elected officer are Engr. Manuel Uy (President), Engr. Albert Joseph Gonzalo Monge (Vice President), Paz Marie Somcio (Secretary), Everlou Maquiling (Treasurer), Jasmin Gura (Auditor), Loriejen Dequilato (Public Information Officer), and Charwin Padilla (Business Manager).

- The Commission on Filipinos Overseas (CFO) held the Community Education Program on Migration at Room AB 104, Alijis Campus on August 27, 2024 as part of its campaign to raise awareness on the agency's programs and activities. The activity was participated in by staff members from the Alijis Campus and Fortune Towne Campus, who also learned migration realities and government policies.
- The Records Management Unit conducted a seminar-workshop on records disposition administration last August 28, 2025. Staff members from Alijis, Binalbagan, Fortune Towne and Talisay attended the activity.
