- 5th District Rep. Dino Yulo officially turned over the Administration Building, Fisheries Laboratory, and all-gender comfort rooms to

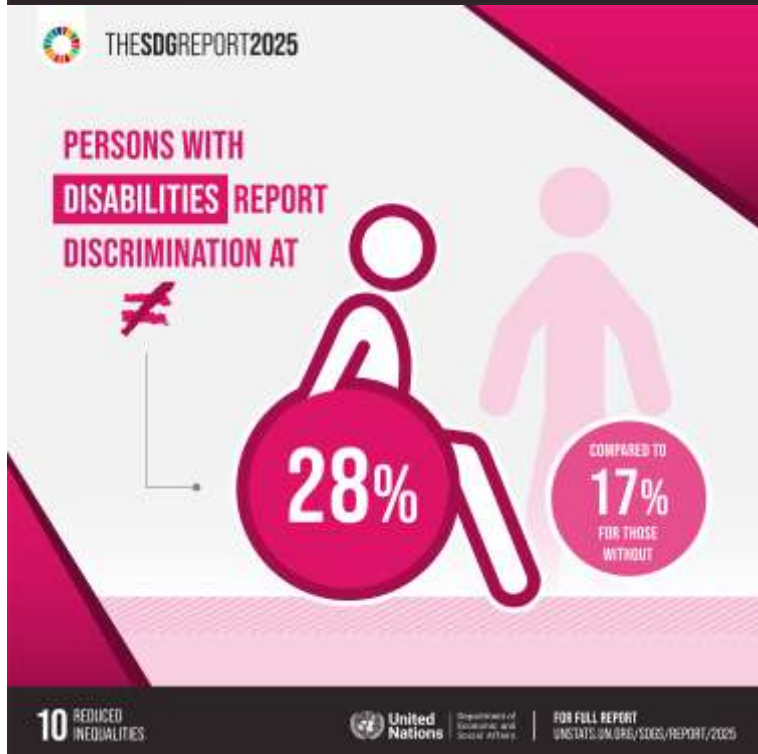
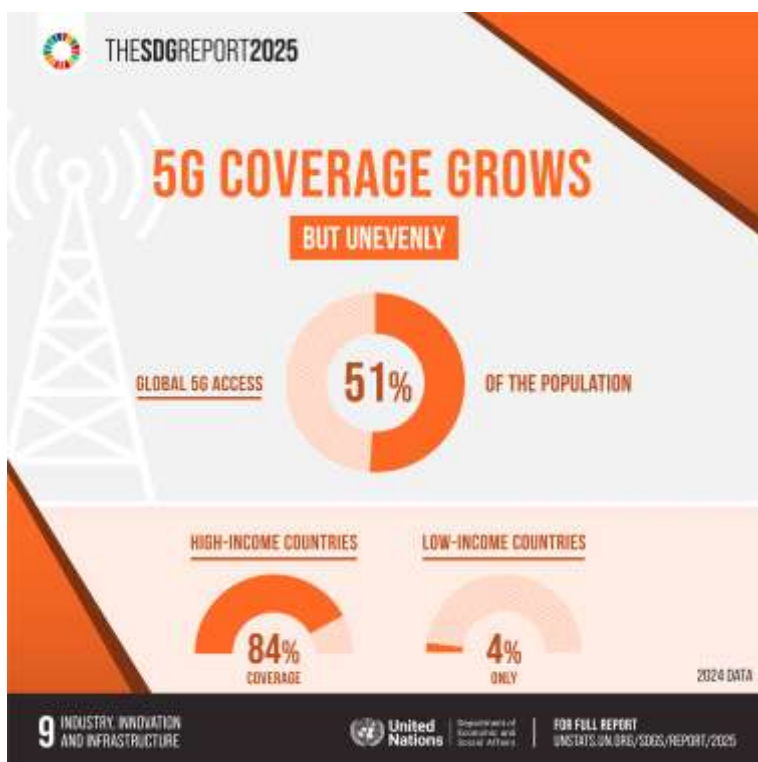
