

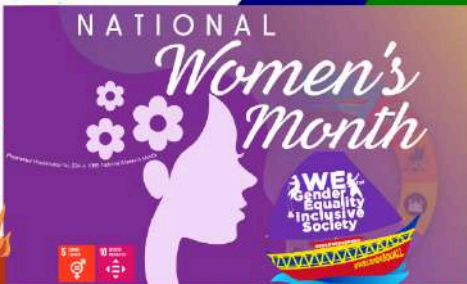

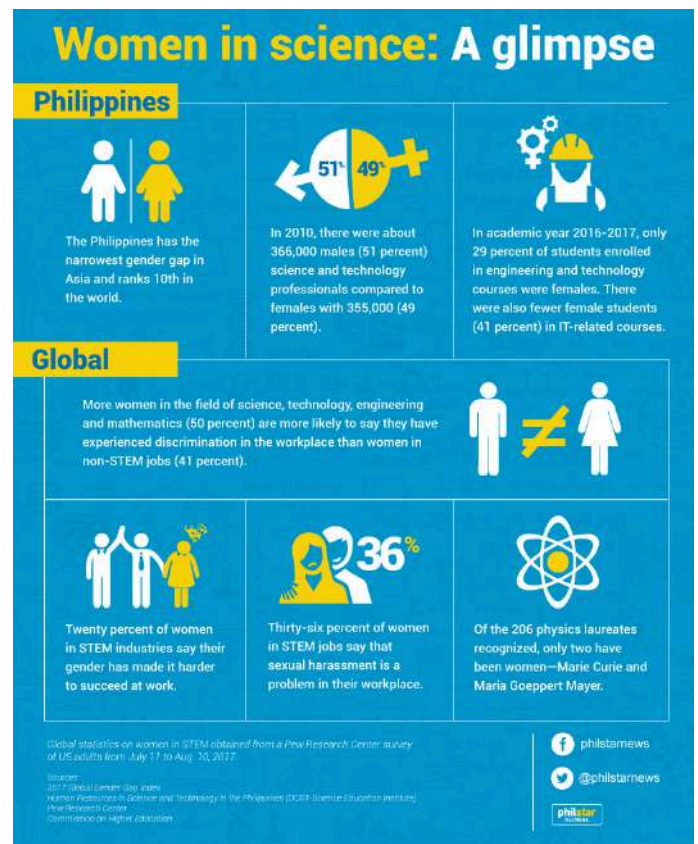

Highlights of the Week

- The Department of Education Schools Division of Victorias City visited Carlos Hilado Memorial State University on February 26, 2026, to benchmark on the disposal of unserviceable government properties. The session on knowledge-sharing between the two institutions was led by the CHMSU Disposal Committee and held at the Conference Room, Administration Building, Talisay (Main) Campus.
- The Bachelor of Arts in English Language (BAEL) Class of 2026 proudly held its Pinning Ceremony titled "Pen and the Mind: Pillars of Knowledge" on February 26, 2026, at the Multi-purpose Gymnasium, Talisay (Main) Campus.
- The Bachelor of Arts in Social Science (BASS) Class of 2026 held its Pinning Ceremony titled "Padayun Para sa Damgo: Pinning the Future of Society Class of 2026" on March 3, 2026, at the Multi-purpose Gymnasium, Talisay (Main) Campus.
- In line with the latest issuances and requirements of the Government Procurement Policy Board (GPPB) and the Department of Budget and Management (DBM), the Procurement Management Unit conducted its 2027 Procurement Planning session for the Talisay Campus on March 4, 2026, and in the Fortune Towne and Alijis Campuses on March 6, 2026.
- Selected students and faculty members of the College of Computer Studies at CHMSU Alijis Campus attended an orientation with the Philippine National IT Standards Foundation, held at the Conference Room on March 3, 2026. Led by resource speaker Engr. Karlo Fausto Soriano, head of PHILNITS, the orientation equipped attendees with essential information on what to prepare for and how to obtain international IT certification.
- The Podbokasiya series of episode screenings made its final stop at the Talisay (Main) Campus Audio-Visual Room on March 4, 2026. Attended by class mayors, club presidents,

and first-year and third-year students from the BA Social Science program, the video podcast screening—held in two sessions—served as a platform for discussion on how students can contribute positively in times of disasters.

- First-year Bachelor of Industrial Technology major in Culinary Technology students of the College of Industrial Technology conducted the Pinning Ceremony held at the Audio-Visual Room, Alijis Campus on March 6, 2026.
- The CHMSU Debate League successfully held the first four rounds of the 2nd Intercollege Debate Competition on March 5, 2026 at the Global Learning Cafe, Talisay Campus. The activity was held in partnership with the Federation of University Student Government and C-USG Talisay.
- The CHMSU community in Fortune Towne and Talisay campuses came together to celebrate the First Friday Masses on March 6, 2026. Students, faculty, and staff welcomed the first week of March with prayer, reflection, and thanksgiving.
- Kabataan Partylist – Negros, together with Katipunan ng Kabataan Laban sa Korapsyon (KKK), mounted the REAL TALK: Fronting Issues from the Forgotten Frontlines, a day of learning that brought together with the voices of the youth and local communities to discuss pressing issues such as systemic corruption, the Anti-Political Dynasty Bills in the 20th Philippine Congress, and the ongoing campaigns of local communities across Negros. The activity was in collaboration with C-USG Talisay and CIER.
- The Office for Student Affairs and Services (OSAS) conducted a Stakeholders' Consultation on the Student Handbook on March 2, 2026 via Zoom across all campuses. The activity gathered representatives of the student body, administration, faculty, and staff to discuss and consult on the matters concerning the Student Handbook.
- The CHMSU-FT CUSG organized a Piso-Piso Campaign for Barangay 39 to support families affected by a recent fire incident. A donation booth was arranged outside the Audio Visual Room (AVR) to encourage the CHMSU-FT community to contribute to the campaign. The program was carried out by CHMSUyanihan under the CHMSU institution.
- The College of Education at the Binalbagan Campus held a send-off and thanksgiving ceremony on March 6, 2026, for the September 2025 LEPT passers and takers for 2026.
- The CIER, FCUSG, and volunteer students turned over the CHMSUyanihan para sa Nasunugan sa Brgy. 39 donations to the Brgy. 39 officials and Bacolod City Department of Social Services and Development on March 7, 2026.
