

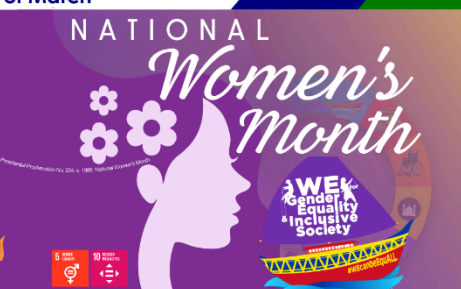

## Highlights of the Week

- CHMSU and the Regional Recruitment and Selection Unit–Negros Island Region (RRSU–NIR) formally sealed their partnership through a Memorandum of Agreement signing ceremony on March 17, 2026. Held at the Business Center of the CHMSU Talisay (Main) Campus, University President Norberto Mangulabnan and PLtCol. Jacob Crisostomo signed the agreement on behalf of the two institutions. Under the agreement, CHMSU, through the College of Criminal Justice, will take the lead in program design, research coordination, faculty development, and provision of venues and facilities.
- On March 17, 2026, Pag-IBIG Fund services were brought closer to the CHMSU Fortune Towne community through the Lingkod Pag-IBIG on Wheels.
- Mount Carmel College of Escalante, Inc. conducted a benchmarking activity at the CHMSU-FT Campus Advanced Education Programs Library, where both institutions exchanged best library practices.
- Campus publications from across the Negros Island Region gathered for the College Editors Guild of the Philippines – Negros Island Region (CEGP-NIR) Unification Meeting at the University of St. La Salle on March 14. Organized by the College Editors Guild of the Philippines, the meeting was also attended by CHMSU student publications.
- CHMSU has unveiled a major information technology modernization initiative aimed at transforming its network infrastructure across four campuses in Negros Occidental. The system was formally received by CHMSU from LMI Corporation in a ceremonial signing and turnover held on March 13, 2026, at the Global Learning Cafe, CHMSU Talisay (Main) Campus.
- Representatives of ARCH Plus Co., Ltd. paid a courtesy visit to the Center for Internationalization and External Relations (CIER) on March 18, 2026, to discuss employment opportunities in Japan for CHMSU graduates. CIER Director Rhoderick Samonte, together with university officers, welcomed ARCH Plus CEO Seto Yohko, who also serves as COO of Sachi Japanese International School; Yamahei Training and Assessment Center CEO Yamada Fumio; consultant Imelda Sawamura; and Gengo Kenshu Center representatives.
