Highlights of the Week



- All Roads Lead to CHMSU in Talisay City and Binalbagan kicked off the weeklong festivities for the 4th University Foundation Week. The simultaneous fun run activities were organized by the Federation of Alumni Association of CHMSC (FAAC), Inc., CHMSU Fortune Towne Alumni Association, Alumni Relations Office, Sports Affairs Office, and Stride Events.
- Carlos Hilado Memorial State University (CHMSU) formally launched its 5th PRIME_CHMSU Fiesta on May 11, 2026 at the Talisay (Main) Campus, opening with a ceremony and ribbon-cutting at the Research, Innovation, and Extension (RIE) Hub. The week-long celebration was organized by the Office of the Vice President for Research, Extension, and Intellectual Property (VPREIP) and held in conjunction with CHMSU's 4th University Foundation Week.
- CHMSU and the Bacolod Business Community (BBC) has officially formalized their partnership in a MOA signing ceremony held on May 11, 2026, at the AVR, CHMSU Talisay (Main) Campus. CHMSU was represented by Pres. Norberto Mangulabnan, VP for Research Extension and IP Ma. Rizal Manalo, Director for Intellectual Property Management Director Armando Reosura, and Director for Internationalization and External Relations Rhoderick Samonte. Also present were VP for Academic Affairs Engr. Russel Dela Torre and VP for Administration and Finance Jay Estrellas. Meanwhile, BBC was represented by Pres. - Carlos Hilado Memorial State University further solidified its commitment to the environment as the university inaugurated the sanitary toilet system of the Materials Recovery Facility (MRF) made of Enviro-blocks as walls on May 11, 2026.
