Magbanua, a violin rendition of “Paraiso” by Christine Belgira, and many more.

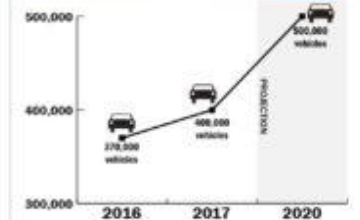
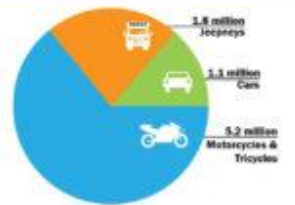

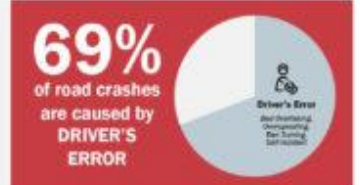


Road crash is the 4th leading cause of death in the Philippines (Department of Health, 2008)

Road crashes amount to **P 2.5 BILLION** in economic loss and societal harm in the Philippines

In Manila, there is an average of **262** crashes per DAY = **11** crashes per HOUR
