## Highlights of the Week

- CHMSU kicked off its Intercampus Sportsfest 2023 and 1st University Foundation Week with the theme “Honoring our Roots. Celebrating our Present. Shaping our Future to Greater Heights” on May 8, 2023. A Thanksgiving Mass was held at each of the four campuses, followed by the Opening Salvo at the Multi-purpose Gym, Talisay (Main) Campus. Each of the eight colleges were presented in a Parade of Gonfalons, followed by the presentation of athletes from each campus. A cauldron was lit in a torch relay to symbolize the light of spirit, knowledge, peace, unity, and life. This was followed by the Oath of Sportsmanship led by Jomel Malan, Badminton RSCUAA 2020 Champion. The program closed with a community dance led by the Student Society of Physical Education Majors.
- Various sports events were held during the Intercampus Sportsfest from May 8 to 12, 2023. These included basketball, volleyball, Arnis, Mobile Legends E-Sports Tournament, badminton, table tennis, football, futsal, taekwondo, beach volleyball, chess, and Sepak Takraw. Likewise, campus clubs and organizations of each campus conducted different pocket activities for the 1st University Foundation Week celebration.
- CHMSU held a Groundbreaking Ceremony for the design and build of the four-storey multi-use Research Innovation and Extension Hub Phase 1

in Talisay (Main) Campus on May 8, 2023. The building was designed to house research offices, laboratories, and spaces for technology and innovation exchange.

- PEPF02 students and faculty held their Culminating Program at the Multi-purpose Gym, Talisay (Main) Campus on May 12, 2023. PEPF02



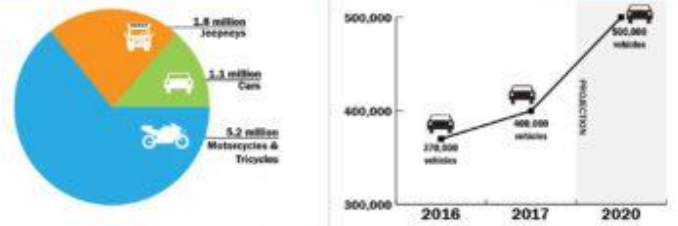

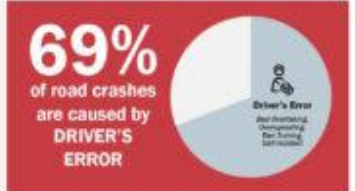


## Road crash is the 4th leading cause of death in the Philippines (Department of Health, 2008)

**Natural Heritage with Cultural Significance**

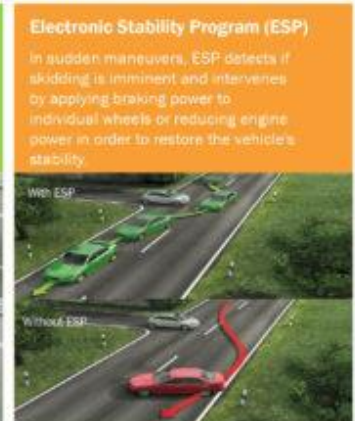
mountains, volcanoes, forests, caves, rice fields, plants, animals, rocks, minerals, etc.
