Less than **10%** of that space has been explored by humans.

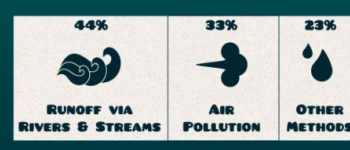
**90%** of the volume constitutes the dark, cold environment we call the deep sea.

 <b>BLUEFIN TUNA</b> The greatest enemy of tuna is overfishing, overfishing.	 <b>SEA TURTLES</b> Fishing gear is the sea turtles' worst enemy, as well as loss of habitat and climate change.	 <b>GRAY WHALE</b> Centuries of overfishing have left one population extinct and one critically endangered.	 <b>CORAL</b> Ocean acidification and bottom trawling commercial fishing are its major threats.	 <b>VAQUITA</b> Threatened by the gill nets used to catch fish, they are often killed unintentionally as bycatch.
