## Beware: ONLINE SCAMS

Innocent people being cheated out of their money and personal information is hitting the headlines almost constantly nowadays, so Data Label have looked into the different types of scams that you might face online every day. Here are some online scams you need to beware of.

### YOUR PERCEPTION

Emails are passed from your computer straight to your friends.

### THE REALITY

Emails are stored at the server for collection and delivery when passing between computers, like an online mail sorting office.

### HOW THE SCAM WORKS

Malicious server searches your email content for bank details, money requests, passwords and other personal data.

If there are any weaknesses or they find any personal information they can abuse, they will.

### HOW TO AVOID SCAMS

- Do not click on links or download attachments in emails you're not certain of, even if the address and message look legitimate.
- A bank will NEVER ask for your PIN or password via email. If you're unsure, call the bank to check.
- If you realize too late and have already given away details, contact your bank immediately.
- Do not open or respond to emails that offer "too good to be true" deals.
- Watch out for poor spelling or grammar in the email - this is a sign it's been faked.
- Make sure your browser and antivirus software are up to date as these can notify you of malicious links before you click them.
- Use a spam filter on your email inbox - these can catch emails before they even reach you.
- Report the scam if it appears to come from an official body - you can help other people avoid it in future.
