## Highlights of the Week

Binalbagan Campus held the Commencement Exercises for Class of 2023 with the theme “Shaping the Future through Globalized Education for Sustainable Development” at the Binalbagan Gym, Municipality of Binalbagan on June 19, 2023. A total of 677 graduates from the College of Business Management and Accountancy, College of Computer Studies, College of Criminal Justice, College of Education and College of Fisheries were conferred their degrees. Remia A. Aparri, Regional Director, Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR)-Regional Field Office VI, relayed the message of Commencement Speaker Atty. Demosthenes R. Escoto, National Director, BFAR, who was unable to make it to the ceremony.

The Intellectual Property Management Office (IPMO) held a three-day Echo-Seminar on Intellectual Property Masterclass at the Function Hall, Green Building, Talisay (Main) Campus on June 19-21, 2023. The seminar aimed to provide members of the faculty and administration from the four campuses, who are involved in technology and industry projects or research, a deeper understanding of intellectual property, its different categories, and important
