The orientation officially welcomed the students to the program and discussed the three components of NSTP namely, the Reserve Officers Training Corps (ROTC), the Civic Welfare Training Service (CWTS), and the Literacy Training Service (LTS). The orientation was conducted simultaneously in all campuses.

- On September 23, 2022, the Carlos Hilado Memorial State University Student Government – Alijis Campus spearheaded the elections of each club for AY 2022-2023. The elections were conducted online and results were announced on the club Facebook pages on the same day.

- CHED Regional Office VI and the Technical Working Group (TWG) conducted an evaluation and review of the Land Use Development and Infrastructure Plan (LUDIP) of Carlos Hilado Memorial State University on September 27, 2022 in Talisay (Main) Campus, September 28, 2022 in Binalbagan Campus, and September 29, 2022 in Alijis and Fortune Towne campuses.
- “Bayanihan para sa Kauswagan” Memorandum of Agreement involving Carlos Hilado Memorial State University, IF Green Technologies, Bacolod Police Station 2, Association of Barangay Councils of Police Station 2, and the City Government of Bacolod, was signed on September 27, 2022 at the Function Hall, Green Building, Talisay (Main) Campus. This agreement was created to



target the implementation of the UN Sustainable Goals (SDGs) locally, especially at the barangay level.

- The Wordsmiths club of the College of Education English Department held its election of officers for AY 2022-2023 on September 29, 2022 at the Function Hall, Green Building, Talisay (Main) Campus.
- A set of textbooks was donated by the Hilado Family to the Carlos Hilado Memorial State University on September 29, 2022. The donation was received by President Norberto P. Mangulabnan, PhD.
- A seminar-workshop on Research-based Community Development Project Proposal Making was conducted by the Extension and Community Services on September 29-30, 2022 at Mambukal Resort & Wildlife Sanctuary. The workshop was participated by the ECS Coordinators and Faculty Extensionist of the different colleges.
- On September 30, 2022, CHMSU launched the 3Zero Club at the Function Hall, Green Building, Talisay (Main) Campus. This was formed in partnership with the Negros Women for Tomorrow Foundation (NWTF) and the Technological University of the Philippines - Visayas with the intention to engage the community, especially the students, in initiatives for creating a world of three zeros — zero net carbon emission, zero wealth concentration for ending poverty, and zero unemployment by unleashing entrepreneurship in all.
