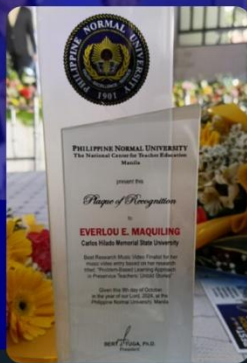

ECONOMIC CHALLENGES

LOST JOBS
High unemployment, poverty rates, inadequate infrastructure, and reliance on fossil fuels.

ENVIRONMENTAL CHALLENGES

Environmental disasters and sustainable development, policies and regulations affecting businesses, waste management systems, and greenhouse gas emissions reduction targets.

POLITICAL AND REGULATORY CHALLENGES

Bureaucracy and red tape, regulatory uncertainties, slow infrastructure development, and limited foreign ownership.

CORRUPTION CHALLENGES

Pervasive corruption in the government and business sector, anti-corruption efforts by the government, and slow implementation of anti-corruption laws.
