## Highlights of the Week

- The College of Education at the Talisay Campus ranked 6th among the top-performing schools in the category of 50-99 first-time examinees, achieving an impressive passing rate of at least 90% for the Elementary Level in the September 2024 Licensure Examination for Teachers based on the results released by the Professional Regulation Commission (PRC). CHMSU has a total of 75 passers for the Elementary Level and 176 in the Secondary Level from the Alijis, Binalbagan, and Talisay (Main) campuses.
- Patricia Mae Maglaque placed 7th in the September 2024 LET (Elementary Education), she is a proud graduate of the Bachelor of Special Needs Education program at the Talisay Campus.
- The 2024 Regional State Colleges and Universities Athletic Association (RSCUAA) Sports Festival and Conference hosted by the Iloilo State University of Fisheries Science and Technology (ISUFST) in Barotac Nuevo, Iloilobegan on December 15, 2024, with CHMSU athletes, supported by coaches, faculty and staff, set to compete in the games until December 20.
