- In line with the 3rd CHMSU_PRIME Fiesta, the College of Arts and Sciences held the Exploring Frontiers, a colloquium on students' researches at the Audio Visual Room of Talisay Campus, on December 16, 2024.
- The College of Education fourth-year students at the Talisay Campus convened at the Multipurpose Gym for the Data-driven Assembly of Graduating Students to Amplify Research (DAGSA), on December 16, 2024.
- CHMSU Binalbagan held the Unilluminating: A Christmas Spectacle on December 16, 2024. Student groups and organizations competed in the Daigon and Barkadahan dance Showdown while Christmas-themed booths were on display in various areas on the campus grounds and followed by the lighting ceremony.
