FIRE SAFETY TIPS

IN CASE OF FIRE

- Stay calm and evacuate immediately.
- On opening doors, Check door handle first. If Hot, DO NOT OPEN as the room may already be on fire.
- Use the stairs and do not use the elevator in case you are in a buildings.
- If there is smoke, get down low, cover your nose and mouth with damp cloth
- STOP, DROP and ROLL to put out the flames
- If your clothes catch fire, STOP, DROP and ROLL to put out the flames
- Sound alarm and call for help
- Have yourself checked for injuries
- Do not return inside your house or building unless authorities deemed it safe
- If trapped, stay in the room, signal for help using a bright colored cloth at the window of make noise
- Call the Fire Department or 911
